The Faculty of Medicine, Srinakharinwirot University, Thailand in collaboration with the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, the University of Nottingham, UK offer the direct admission to a Joint Medicine Programme. This programme provides a new alternative for students with good Sciences knowledge and English skill from Thai and international schools in Thailand and overseas to study preclinical subjects abroad and clinical subjects in Thailand. The enrolled students will study Biomedical Science subjects at the University of Nottingham for 3 years and will be awarded the Bachelor Degree of Medical Sciences (B.Med.Sci.) from the University of Nottingham. After that, they will carry on their clinical studies at the Faculty of Medicine, Srinakharinwirot University. Upon completion of the study, the students will be awarded the Doctor of Medicine degree (M.D.) from Srinakharinwirot University.



Application requirements:

1. Being Thai citizen and Thai nationality
2. Graduated or about to graduate from M.6 from Thai High Schools with grade point average from M.4 to M.6 with a minimum of 3.00 OR
3. Graduated or about to graduate from grade 12 from International Schools in Thailand or overseas with grade point average from grade 10 to grade 12 with a minimum of 3.00 or equivalent
4. IELTS (The International English Language Testing System) with a total score no less than 7.0 in total and no less than 6.5 for each modules
